



Program Descriptions

Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced ESOL courses focused on engaging the Boston community in order to increase their English conversational skills, ultimately improving their engagement in the workforce, education, and everyday life.

- Beginner Focus: Develop ability to have short Conversations with Support - learning how to exchange limited information on familiar topics and ask and answer simple questions about basic needs with support.
- Intermediate Focus: Develop students' ability to elaborate beyond the minimum communications and appropriately adapt their level of politeness to the social context. They will also learn to narrate a sequence of events and summarize information from different sources.
- Advanced Focus: Further develop literacy and writing skills and engage in advanced discourse.

- Program would include *six* 8-week cycles.
- Classes would be held Monday and Wednesday evenings from 6:00pm until 7:00pm, with the possibility to add more options as the program grows.
- Placement interviews would potentially be held on a continual basis.
- Partner organizations would sign annual contracts to enroll a set number of students in classes.
- BCEC will submit one invoice at the start of the year.
- Choose a student buy-in option with a small registration fee, or have them register at no cost.
- Program subject to expansion as needed.
